Aug. 13-16: According to a Cerigua report, 30 persons were victims of politically-motivated murder in 11 of Guatemala's 22 departments. Fourteen of the victims were abducted and then murdered/prior to their murder. Corpses were found along roadsides, in a cemetery, on city streets, in a garbage dump and in tiny villages in the countryside. (Basic data from Cerigua weekly briefs, 08/13-19/90)
