## **Brazil: Industrial Output Growth Rates, Sao Paulo & Rio De Janeiro States**

On Feb. 19, the official statistics agency (Instituto Brasileiro de Geografia e Estatistica-IBGE) reported a 4% increase in Sao Paulo state industrial output in December 1989, relative to the last month in 1988. The rate for November was 9%, and October, 12%, compared to respective months in 1988. Sao Paulo's industrial product for the year was 2% higher than the 1988 total. In Rio de Janeiro state, industrial product in the month of December dropped 2.4% compared to December 1988. For 1989 as a whole, Rio de Janeiro showed a 4.3% increase over 1988.
