On Sept. 24, Emergent Unity Movement (Movimiento Emergence Concordia-MEC) party secretary Juan Francisco Flores was assassinated by unidentified gunmen in Santa Rosa department. MEC presidential candidate former general Benedito Lucas Garcia confirmed that other party members working on his campaign have been subjected to violent attacks and death threats.
