Guatemala: Rios Montt Leads In Poll

Poll results released Sept. 27 indicated that 35% of respondents selected retired general Efraim Rios Montt as first choice for president in the Nov. 11 elections. Jorge Carpio, candidate of the National Center Union (UCN), came in second, with 23.1%. The survey was conducted by Honduran firm Tecnologia Empresaria between Sept. 17 and 23. Additional poll results follow: Alvaro Arzu, National Advance Party (PAN), 12.5%; Jorge Serrano Elias, Solidarity Action Movement (MAS), 10%; Alfonso Cabrera, Christian Democrat Party, 7.1%.
