On Oct. 3, the Aero-Industrial Services Cooperative (Cooperativa de Servicios Aeroindustriales R.L.-COOPESA) and the firm Frontline signed a contract to export ambulances to the US. COOPESA specializes in aircraft repairs and automotive vehicle assembly. According to COOPESA spokespersons, the ambulances are manufactured with strict adherence to requirements of the US market, at a cost 30% below competitors. (Basic data from AFP, 10/03/90)
