Guatemala: Christian Democrat Party Invites Election Observers From International Organizations

On Oct. 11 at a press conference with foreign reporters in Guatemala City, Christian Democrat Party presidential candidate Alfonso Cabrera said the party had invited several international organizations to send teams to observe the Nov. 11 elections. Included are the Christian Democrat, Social Democrat and Social Conservative internationals. At a press conference with foreign reporters, Cabrera said over 100 observers are expected, and the party hopes that the monitors will be on hand not only on election day, but for at least 15 days, covering a portion of the campaign, and/or the vote count.
