## **Guatemala: Rios Montt's Name Printed On Ballots**

On Oct. 11, the Supreme Electoral Tribunal ordered the printing of 3.2 million ballots to include name of retired general Efraim Rios Montt. Guatemala's Supreme Court of Justice has not yet ruled on the legality of Rios Montt's presidential candidacy. Two sets of ballots are being printed, one set with 12 presidential candidates, and the other with 13, including Rios Montt. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 10/11/90)
