Results of a survey conducted by Guillermo Bravo y Asociados April 19-20 show a 42% approval rating for President Carlos Menem. According to the results released April 29, if elections took place today, Menem would receive 32% of the vote, and Radical Civic Union politician Eduardo Angeloz, 21%. Of the total, 16% of respondents said the president's image was "excellent," while 26% said it was "very good." (Basic data from Miami Herald, Xinhua, 04/30/90)
