In an Oct. 24 broadcast by Radio Farabundo Marti, the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) announced that it would declare a cease-fire as soon as the US cuts all military aid to the government. According to the rebels, Washington has three options: maintain or increase aid to the Salvadoran army; reduce or place conditions on the aid; or, completely abandon a "corrupt and murderous" ally."
