Guatemala: Abducted Teacher's Body Found In Lake Amatitlan

On Nov. 1, the body of Eduardo Estuardo Alvarado Morales was found in Lake Amatitlan, located 30 km. south of the capital. Alvarado Morales, a teacher at the Maria Luisa Mayoa Lanuzas National Institute and a private secondary school, was abducted on Nov. 20, 1989. Medical examiners said Alvarado had been shot several times and tortured before his body was dumped into the lake. According to Notimex, motives for the victim's abduction were unknown, and police made no headway in identifying the perpetrators in the past year. (Basic data from Notimex, 11/01/90)
