Guatemala: Notes On Recent Fighting

On Nov. 4, daily newspaper Prensa Libre reported that on Nov. 1 guerrillas launched a mortar attack against the ranch used as a retreat by President Vinicio Cerezo. Several soldiers were injured, and buildings damaged. Next, the newspaper said six soldiers were injured and one tank damaged in a clash with rebels in Huehuetenango department. Also in Huehuetenango, the Guerrilla Army of the Poor (EGP) downed two electricity pylons, and felled trees on the Pan-American highway to obstruct traffic.
