Guatemalan Refugees To Be Resettled In Mexico's Campeche State

On Nov. 6, Hector Navarrete Hernandez, national coordinator for COMAR (Mexican Commission on Aid to Refugees), announced that 90 Guatemalan refugees will be resettled Nov. 8 at the Los Laureles camp in Campeche state. He said the refugees are part of a larger group of 350 Guatemalans currently residing Pujiltic, Chiapas state. Navarrete Hernandez said the government has opted to relocate Guatemalans camped near the border in an effort to avoid further "bilateral conflicts." The resettlement program, he added, is to be completed in January. The Los Laureles camp will accommodate 400 families. (Basic data from Notimex, 11/06/90)
