On Nov. 8, President George Bush signed a proclamation including Nicaragua among beneficiaries of Washington's Caribbean Basin Initiative (CBI). The CBI will permit the customs-free entry into the US market of a wide range of Nicaraguan exports, with the exceptions of textiles, clothing, canned tuna, petroleum and derivatives, most leather products, and watches containing components imported from "communist countries."
