In a communique released Nov. 13 in San Salvador, the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) high command said the March 1991 congressional and municipal elections will "not be free, nor honest," in the absence of previous substantive peace agreements between the government and the rebels. The FMLN said its participation in the elections is contingent upon reaching agreements leading to the demilitarization of Salvadoran society. (Basic data from Notimex, Xinhua, 11/13/90)
