On Nov. 11 in Madrid, after the conclusion of the 32nd congress of the Spanish Socialist Workers Party (PSOE), Bayardo Arce told reporters that a Marshall Plan is necessary for Nicaragua, paid for by the international community, but mainly the US. Arce is a member of the Sandinista National Liberation Front's directorship. In remarks on topics discussed at the congress, Arce said that the Sandinistas had implemented during their years in power the concepts of party pluralism, and free market economy.
