German Assistance To Nicaragua, 1990

In 1990, Nicaragua received 25 million marks (\$16.6 million) to purchase seeds and fertilizers, and 1.5 million marks (\$1 million) to finance agricultural research. The government in Bonn also provided technical assistance to Nicaragua in 1990 valued at 14.7 million marks (\$9.8 million). At the conclusion of a meeting in Bonn with Nicaraguan Economy Minister Silvio de Franco, German Economic Cooperation Minister Juergen Warnke said his government will continue providing aid to Managua in 1991. Technical assistance, however, will decline compared to 1990. (Basic data from AFP, 11/15/90)
