Central American Economic Integration Bank (bcie) Loans To Honduras (s/s)

On Nov. 13, the Central American Economic Integration Bank (BCIE) released a report on loans to Honduras through Aug. 31, 1990. Since the bank was established, the bank approved a total \$567.5 million for Honduras, of which \$164.4 million had not yet been disbursed. Tegucigalpa accounted for 27.5% of all BCIE loans thus far disbursed to Central American nations. Of a total 293 loans, 134 were earmarked for the public sector, valued at \$418.8 million, while the private sector was allocated 134 loans valued at \$148.7 million. BCIE loans to Honduras by sector, and total value are summarized below.
