## **Nicaragua: Results Of President's Meeting With Leaders Of Contra-u.n.o. Mayor Rebellion**

On Nov. 21 in Juigalpa, capital of Chontales department, President Violeta Barrios de Chamorro and members of her cabinet met with 18 mayors who had launched a series of protests reportedly supporting demands by former contras for land. (See CAU issues beginning 11/07/90 for previous coverage of protest.) President Barrios de Chamorro rejected demands for the obligatory resignations of army chief Gen. Humberto Ortega, Presidency Minister Antonio Lacayo, and Interior Minister Carlos Hurtado. Concessions to the protesters are summarized below: \* 500 soldiers are to be removed from Region V. \* Military bases in the country are to be cut back from 34 to 18. \* Wounded contras are to receive pensions. \* Immediate action will be taken to provide land to demobilized contras in the region.
