On Nov. 27, President Violeta Barrios de Chamorro announced the creation of a National Disarmament Commission, charged with supervising disarmament of civilians who received weapons from the previous government during the war with the contras. The commission is comprised of army chief Gen. Humberto Ortega, Interior Minister Carlos Hurtado, and Presidency Minister Antonio Lacayo.
