On Nov. 30 in Madrid, Presidency Minister Antonio Lacayo said Washington has disbursed only \$70 million of the \$500 million approved by the Congress for 1990 and 1991. He added that the US has a responsibility to provide more financing to help save the democracy it claimed to be fighting for by funding the contra war for several years.
