On Nov. 29 in Madrid, Presidency Minister Antonio Lacayo met with Spanish President Felipe Gonzalez. At a press conference the following day, the minister said Gonzalez had pledged \$45 million in development aid for Nicaragua, and to begin talks within a few months on restructuring Managua's debt to Spain.
