Honduras: European Economic Community Provides \$130,000 In Emergency Assistance For Flood Victims

On Dec. 11 in Brussels, the European Economic Community's executive commission announced the approval of 100,000 ECUs (about \$130,000) in emergency assistance earmarked for Honduran flood victims. Heavy rains in northern Honduras last month caused several deaths, and left 13,000 people homeless. A total of 950,000 Hondurans were affected. (Basic data from AFP, 12/11/90)
