On Oct. 18, the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) announced that it will provide \$2.54 million in aid for small-scale community development projects in El Salvador. The aid will become part of a fund administered by the non-governmental Canadian Hunger Foundation for distribution to local NGOs in charge of the projects.
