On July 3, Brazilian Foreign Minister Francisco Rezek said Brasilia and Buenos Aires have decided to cut by half the time period projected for achieving integration of the two nations' economies, and accelerating the establishment of a common market in the Southern Cone. In talks over the past two years, government officials had agreed on a 10-year process, now reduced to five years. (Basic data from Notimex, 07/03/90)
