On Dec. 13 in San Pedro Sula, a bomb exploded near the headquarters of a Liberal Party faction, known as the Liberal Renewal Political Movement (LIBRE). Police Sgt. Edgardo Zeron Larios said that a guard was seriously injured, and the headquarters building and two others were damaged. LIBRE is headed by Jewish businessperson Jaime Rosenthal Oliva.
