On Dec. 20, the Inter-American Human Rights Commission (CIDH) released a report on its investigation of the Nov. 25, 1988, massacre of 21 civilians in the village of El Aguacate. According to the CIDH, a branch of the Organization of American States, evidence obtained during an "exhaustive" investigation indicated that the Guatemalan National Revolutionary Union (URNG) was responsible. The CIDH said there was no basis for accusations that government troops were involved. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 12/20/90)
