Panama Receives \$107.9 Million Disbursement From \$420 Million Emergency Aid Package

On July 24, the US authorized payment of \$107.9 million to Panama earmarked for recovery of the private sector. The funds are part of the \$420 million of "supplemental emergency aid approved by Congress in May. Thus far, Washington has disbursed \$351.7 million of the package. The remaining \$68.5 million are earmarked for financing of long-term priority projects, such as human resource development, investment and export promotion, national resource administration and investment in environmental programs focused around the Canal.
