According to the July 25 issue of Cuanto S.A. (Peru), average daily price level inflation between Jan. 1 and July 23 was 1.13%. The monthly rate for June was 50%, and economists expect 60% this month. The cumulative inflation rate from July 1985 to July 1990 is estimated at over 2,300,300,000%.
