On Feb. 3, Uruguayan painter Sergio Ives Bulanti was shot to death on the orders of a Guatemalan known as "Del Cid," after an argument about the Persian Gulf War. "Del Cid" ordered his bodyguards to shoot Bulanti after he left the restaurant where he, Bulanti, and another Uruguayan had been discussing the war.
