## **Strike Paralyzes Fishing Activities In Southern Argentina**

On Aug. 22, Roberto Davos, chief of the Argentine Association of Fishing Captains and Owners, told reporters that a strike had shut down fishing activities in southern Argentina. Workers were demanding payment of wages as specified under existing agreements. The strike affected 50 fishing vessels and 500 workers. Fish products from southern Argentina account for 25% of domestic supplies. (Basic data from AFP, 08/22/90)
