## **Honduran President Cancels Authorization For Protestant Group To Implement Experimental Program In Public Schools**

On Feb. 28, President Rafael Callejas announced that he plans to cancel an agreement granting authorization to the Protestant Accelerated Christian Education School of Tomorrow Foundation to conduct an experimental program in five Tegucigalpa public schools. The agreement, dated November 1990, provided the schools with computer and English language courses in exchange for permission to conduct the experimental program. The Catholic Church hierarchy and political opposition parties charged that the program threatened to violate the constitutional separation of church and state. The US-based foundation is currently conducting a similar program in Guatemala. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 02/28/91)
