On March 5, Guatemalan National Revolutionary Unity (URNG) spokesperson Hector Nuila told reporters that the next round of peace talks will take place in Costa Rica. A date for talks has not yet been announced. Participants will include representatives from the URNG, President Jorge Serrano's government, and the National Reconciliation Commission.
