National Republican Alliance (ARENA) candidates elected to the National Assembly in the March 10 elections include former colonel Sigifredo Ochoa, known as a military hardliner, and Francisco Guerrero, who serves as President Alfredo Cristiani's personal secretary. Newly elected Christian Democrat legislators include former foreign minister Ricardo Acevedo, Gerardo Le Chevalier, Eduardo Colindres, and former information minister Roberto Vierda. National Agricultural Workers Union (UNOC) leaders Amanda Villatoro and Simon Parada were also elected to the Assembly. Democratic Convergence candidates elected to the Assembly include Jorge Villacorta, who formerly led the Democratic Revolutionary Front (FDR), Hector Silva, Juan Jose Martel, and Rene Flores. Flores replaced the late Guillermo Ungo on the Democratic Convergence ticket. (Basic data from AFP, 03/13/91)
