## **Venezuela: September Inflation, 1.5%**

On Oct. 1, the Central Bank reported that the consumer price index in September rose 1.5%, down from 3.2% in August. The accumulated rate for the first nine months of the year was calculated at 24.9%. The September 1989 rate was 70.4%. Last month, price inflation for foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco was 0.2%. Prices on footwear rose an average 0.9%, compared to children clothing and footwear at 6.4%. (Basic data from AFP, 10/01/90)
