Guatemala: Office Of Human Rights Attorney General Reports On "extra-judicial" Executions, 1st Quarter 1991

According to an April 24 report by the office of Human Rights Attorney General, 80 "extra-judicial" executions were reported in the first quarter of the year. The report said 14 of the victims were murdered by rebels, five by soldiers, and 61 by individuals "who have not yet been identified." Seventy-three were shot to death. One of the victims was targeted with a grenade, and the remainder were beaten to death. Most of the corpses were found on roadsides. According to the report, of the 80 cases, eight were women, five were minors and 33 adults. The age of 42 victims could not be determined. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 04/24/91)
