## **El Salvador: New Legislature Installed**

On May 1, the new 84-member Legislative Assembly was installed. Assembly members elected Nationalist Republican Alliance (ARENA) member Roberto Angulo as assembly president, and Ciro Cruz Zepeda of the National Conciliation Party, and Ruben Zamora of the Democratic Convergence as vice presidents. Christian Democrat Party (PDC) members refused to participate in the assembly's ruling council when PDC leader Fidel Chavez Mena was not elected assembly president. The composition of the new assembly is as follows: ARENA, 39 deputies; PDC, 26; PCN, nine; Convergence, eight; Nationalist Democratic Union (UDN), one; and, Authentic Christian Movement (MAC), one.
