On Nov. 2, President Carlos Menem announced that all controls on fuel prices will be lifted beginning Jan. 1, 1991. Meanwhile, Economy Ministry sources told reporters that no fuel price hikes are planned for the remainder of the year. At present, gasoline sells for an average \$0.80 per liter.
