Nicaragua: Report On Distribution Of Land Confiscated During Sandinista Administration

On June 26, agrarian reform director Gustavo Tablada submitted a report to the National Assembly on distribution of confiscated property during the administration of the Sandinista National Liberation Front (FSLN). The report included the names of beneficiaries, location of property, and size of redistributed plots. According to the report, 9,000 plots totaling 479,612 ha. were redistributed. Of the 9,000, about half were obtained by 74 individuals. Among the latter are high-ranking former Sandinista government officials. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 06/26/91)
