## **Guyana: World Bank Affiliate Approves \$4.3 Million Loan To Support Structural Adjustments**

On Nov. 7 in Washington, the International Development Association (IDA), a World Bank affiliate, announced approval of a \$4.3 million loan to support the Guyanese government's structural adjustment program. In June this year, the IDA approved a \$78 million loan for the same program. Terms on the two loans are 40 years, 10-year grace period, no standard interest, a 0.75% loan handling commission, and a variable charge of up to 0.5% on the non-disbursed sum. At present, the latter charge is zero. (Basic data from AFP, 11/07/90)
