On July 29, police spokespersons told reporters that the body of British journalist Anson N.G. Yong (or Hanson Jong, as per report by Agence France-Presse) was found in his Guatemala City apartment. The victim worked for the Financial Times of London and Business International. According to police, Jong, who had worked in Guatemala since 1984, was shot to death.
