On Aug. 8, Interior Ministry spokesperson Frank Cesar told reporters that during recent talks between ministry representatives and recontra leader Juan Moran Flores (Indomable), the two sides agreed to a one-week truce while the government studies recontra demands. The talks, carried out in the presence of UN and human rights observers, will resume Aug. 15 in Jinotega department. Cesar said that Indomable was accompanied by 17 men.
