## **Nicaraguan Vice President Says He Was Target Of Assassination Attempt**

On Aug. 19 in San Isidro, Sebaco (Matagalpa department), former Sandinista soldier Francisco Lacayo was killed at a political rally by Ricardo Davila, a former contra. In statements to reporters Aug. 20, Vice President Virgilio Godoy told reporters that Lacayo made an appearance at the rally with the intent to assassinate him. Godoy also said Davila was not his bodyguard. Next, Godoy said he had received death threats prior to the rally. (Basic data from AFP, 08/20/91)
