Guatemala: Suspect Arrested In Connection With Alta Verapaz Massacre

On Aug. 21 in statements to reporters, Interior Ministry spokesperson Gonzalo Asturias said Alfonso Guillermo Coy had been arrested in connection with the Aug. 15 murders of six persons in Coban, Alta Verapaz department. (See CAU 08/21/91 for previous coverage.) Asturias added that police were seeking three other suspects. Attorney General Acisclo Valladares said initial investigations indicated that the massacre was the result of a personal vendetta. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, AFP, 08/21/91)
