## **Nicaragua: Recontra Leader Demands Meeting With President Or Interior Minister**

On Aug. 26, Jose Angel Roman ("Indomable") told local radio station reporters that he not accept intermediaries in negotiations with the government over land, housing or medicine. He asserted that he wanted to speak directly with President Violeta Chamorro or Interior Minister Carlos Hurtado. Roman participated in meetings over the weekend with a government delegation headed by National Assembly Deputy Azucena Ferrey in Jinotega department.
