At an Aug. 28 press conference in Tegucigalpa, Taiwanese Vice President Li Yuan-zu said his government is willing to stimulate private investment in Honduras. After a three-day official visit, the vice president said he was "impressed" by the country's natural resources, work force availability, and political stability.
