On Aug. 21, Foreign Minister Mario Caris told reporters that the National Reconciliation Commission (CNR) is to be reactivated to reopen investigations into the whereabouts of 143 persons disappeared between 1979 and 1984. He said the commission would be restructured and would include a delegate from the International Verification and Support Commission (CIAV) of the Organization of American States (OAS).
