On Aug. 27 in Tegucigalpa, Navy Commander Reynaldo Andino told reporters that the US will provide \$300,000 in aid to the government under a recently concluded anti-drug trafficking pact. In September, a \$25 million radar system, located at the Trujillo port on the Atlantic coast, is scheduled for opening. The radar system, with a range of 250 km., was constructed for purposes of drug interdiction. (Basic data from AFP, 08/27/91)
