On Aug. 22, Foreign Trade Minister Roberto Rojas said the 1991 trade deficit is projected at \$300 million, down from last year's \$600 million. According to reports by the Export Promotion Center (CENPRO), export income has increased by 2.3% compared to 1990. Export revenues last year totaled \$1.9 billion, up 15% compared to 1989.
