Uruguay: 3.5% Inflation In February

On March 2, the General Census and Statistics Administration (Direccion General de Estadistica y Censos- DGEC) reported that consumer price level inflation for February was 3.5%, the lowest monthly rate in over two years. Cumulative inflation over the first two months of the year was 10.98%. (Basic data from AFP, 03/02/91)
