## **Uruguay: European Assistance In Management Training For Small- & Medium-scale Enterprises**

On March 3 in Montevideo, Energy and Industry Minister Augusto Montesdeoca met with a delegation from the Lovaina Catholic University (Belgium), headed by Etienne Cracco, to discuss modifications to a support program for small- and medium-scale enterprises. The program, to commence in the near future, consists of the establishment of consulting groups that later will directly assist a group of selected companies. The latter are to be selected on the basis of expected gains from technical training of managerial staff.
